

Utah Childhood Lead Risk Questionnaire

This questionnaire should be administered to children from **6 months to 6 years of age** at well-child visits. **2-3%** of US preschool-aged children may have an elevated blood lead level of $\geq 5\mu\text{g/dL}$. A blood lead test (venous or capillary) is the only way to know if lead may be negatively affecting a child's health. Blood lead testing is **recommended** on all children at **1 and 2 years** of age. In addition, **all children should be tested:**

- *When there is a "Yes" or "Don't Know" response on any question below*
- *Who **reside or regularly visit** one of the **high-risk zip codes** listed on the back*
- *If they are covered or eligible for **Medicaid insurance** (this is federally mandated at 1 and 2 years of age)*
- *If they are **refugees or immigrate to the USA- Check blood lead level on all children 6 months-16 years within 30-60 days of arrival and recheck 3-6 months after resettlement on children 6 months to 6 years of age.***

5	Does this child have a sibling or playmate who has had an elevated blood lead level?			
6	Does this child frequently try to eat or mouth non-food items?			
7	Is this child a refugee, immigrant or adoptee from a foreign country?			
8	Has this child lived or visited a foreign country such as Mexico, Central or South America, China, India, or Pakistan, where exposure to lead from certain items could have occurred (for example through cosmetics, candies, jewelry, folk medicines, home remedies or glazed pottery)?			
9	Does this child live with someone who has a job or hobby that may involve lead (for example, jewelry making, plumbing, furniture refinishing, working with lead solder or stained glass, reloading or casting bullets, target practice, fishing sinkers, building renovation or repair, automobile batteries, radiators, or bridge construction)?			
10	Has this child ever lived near a factory or operation where lead may have been present or used (for example a mining/milling operation, a smelter, a paint, ammunition or battery factory, or an oil refinery)?			
11	Have you ever been told that your child has a high blood lead level by a healthcare provider?
